## Our Mission

Our mission is to improve the health of the individuals and the communities we serve.

## Vision Statement

Sinai Health System will become the national model for the delivery of urban healthcare.

Located on the west side of Chicago, Sinai Health System is recognized as a national model for urban health care delivery. Sinai Health System is comprised of Mount Sinai Hospital, Sinai Children's Hospital, Schwab Rehabilitation Hospital, Sinai Medical Group, Sinai Community Institute and Sinai Urban Health Institute.

Established 90 years ago to serve Eastern European Jewish immigrants in the area, Sinai Health System continues to focus on the needs of the surrounding community. Caregivers at Sinai are committed to the tradition of tikkun olam — a Hebrew phrase that means “repairing the world.” Sinai's 3,000 caregivers believe that, by their actions, they offer a healing and caring presence for patients, their families and the community.

### Mount Sinai Hospital

Mount Sinai Hospital is a 291-staffed bed teaching hospital that provides medical, surgical, behavioral health, therapeutic and diagnostic services. The Emergency Department is a Level I Trauma Center providing care to nearly 60,000 patients. The Labor and Delivery unit welcomes almost 4,000 newborns — the second highest in the city. A major teaching hospital for the Chicago area, Mount Sinai Hospital trains more than 700 health care professionals.

### Sinai Children's Hospital

Sinai Children's Hospital includes a Level III (the highest level of care) neonatal intensive care unit, a pediatric intensive care unit, pediatric trauma care, and pediatric surgery and anesthesiology. A wide range of specialty pediatric care is available at Sinai Children's Hospital, including gastroenterology, nephrology, allergy, hematology, endocrinology and neurology. It also offers a variety of resources, including a pediatric weight management program and HIV/AIDS program.

### Schwab Rehabilitation Hospital

Schwab Rehabilitation Hospital is a 102-staffed bed facility with comprehensive

inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services for adults and children. Schwab offers a unique therapeutic environment featuring seven treatment gyms with state-of-the-art equipment, a warm-water indoor therapeutic pool and an award-winning therapeutic rooftop garden.

### Sinai Community Institute

Sinai Community Institute (SCI) has a 16-year history of developing community-based health and social service programs. SCI's programs are designed to address the social, economic and environmental factors that affect the health of community members, from infants to adolescents to older adults. Approximately 25,000 clients per year benefit from these services.

### Sinai Urban Health Institute

Sinai Urban Health Institute identifies health disparities and develops programs to address them. Their current initiatives include diabetes, breast cancer, asthma, and smoking cessation. The Institute continues to work with community groups to pursue community-based interventions that will improve health in some of the most vulnerable neighborhoods in the city.

## Commitment to the Community

- Sinai provides nearly \$97 million in community benefits, including charity care, subsidized health services, language assistance, education, research, donations and volunteer services.
- Sinai Interpreter Services, Deaf Access Program and Illinois Video Interpreter Network (IVIN) make health-related communications available 24/7 for foreign language-speaking patients and Deaf and hard of hearing patients.
- Outreach to the community provides valuable health information and resources for people at risk for diabetes, heart disease and other conditions.
- Sinai offers services for teens, work-force development, prenatal health, smoking cessation and asthma management.

## Economic Impact

- With nearly 3,000 employees and an annual operating budget in excess of \$300 million, Sinai is among the largest economic engines on Chicago's West Side.
