



SUHI 2020 Summer Internship Application

Through its partnership with Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science, the Sinai Urban Health Institute (SUHI) is pleased to offer summer internships for Chicago Medical School (CMS) students. The purpose of these internships is to allow CMS students to become more familiar with the fields of public health, population health, and epidemiological research. The 2020 internship runs for 8 weeks, from June 8 to July 31 (40 hours/week). The majority of work will be conducted at [Sinai Urban Health Institute](#), located within Mount Sinai Hospital.

Research projects

Interns will be assigned to a research project. Types of projects include:

- Conducting a literature review and drafting sections of a research brief or paper
- Developing health education materials such as infographics
- Assisting with a proposal, project evaluation plan, or other research task

Lectures, workshops, and field trips

In addition to the project to which the student is assigned, all students will participate in a diverse series of educational activities.

Lectures: Experts will be invited to speak to the students on a variety of public health topics.

Examples: health disparities, the role of community health workers, determinants of health

Workshops: Interactive workshops will be held to improve students' skills related to public health research methods.

Examples: conducting a literature review, reading research articles, data visualization

Field trips: The students will tour several local communities, such as North and South Lawndale, and organizations within these communities to better understand the nature of disparities in our city.
